Tournament Conditions:

This year the tournament will be played in two levels dependant on numbers.

LEVEL 1: Experienced match players able to compete in Hampshire/Portsmouth division 1 or 2 LEVEL 2: Competent match players able to compete in Hampshire/ Portsmouth lower leagues

- 1. The tournament will be run in strict accordance with the ITF Rules of Tennis, the Rules of the LTA and the LTA Tournament Regulations, including the LTA Code of Conduct.
- 2. The IOW Championships is a closed tournament. Eligibility for entry: born on the IOW, schooled on the IOW, living on the IOW, working on the IOW, own a property/residence on the IOW or be a current paid up member of a tennis club on the IOW (temporary holiday/weekly membership is available at RLTCC).
- 3. Players should select the most appropriate level to enter but are entitled to select a higher level if they so wish.
- 4. Entries close at 6pm on Friday 13 September 2019. Cheques payable to RLTCC. No entry will be accepted without the entry fee of £10 per singles event and £10 per player for doubles events. An entry form from both doubles players must be received. Entries to be given to or sent to Mrs Lynn Sandy, c/o Ryde Lawn Tennis and Croquet Club, Playstreet Lane, Ryde, PO33 3LJ.
- 5. All first-round matches can be seen on the notice board at RLTCC. It is the players responsibility to establish the date and time of their first match. All first-round matches will commence on Saturday 21 or Sunday 22 September and subsequent rounds will be played throughout the following week starting at 6.30 enabling all finals to be played on Sunday 29 September. Matches could be scheduled during the day if both participants are available.
- 6. Players may enter a maximum of two events on the understanding that they are available to play early rounds during the week and that all finals will be played on Sunday 29 September. A maximum of 16 players will be allowed in any one category.
- 7. The committee reserve the right to withdraw an event for which there is not a minimum entry and to refuse any entry without stating a reason.
- 8. Players must sign the attendance sheet on arrival and must not thereafter leave the grounds without the Referee's agreement.
- 9. During the tournament all players must wear recognised tennis clothing with any advertising matter or logos conforming to LTA rules.
- 10. Matches will be scheduled for artificial grass courts. The grass courts and floodlights may have to be used if required. Appropriate tennis shoes for the court surface should be worn. ITF approved tennis balls will be provided.
- 11. On entering this tournament, players agree to being involved in any publicity related to the event, RLTCC or the LTA i.e. press/photography/website. Please inform the referee before the start of the tournament if you do not wish to be involved.
- 12. No complaint can be considered by the Tournament committee unless made in writing and given to the Referee within 48 hours of the occurrence.
