Veteran's Tournament:

Westridge/Skoda

Wimbledon Ballot

Last year the ballot was held after the AGM on Thursday 21 March 2019. If all the information is available the ballot will conclude the AGM on March 26 2020.

Astroturf Courts

March 2019 saw the existing carpet replaced with Tiger Turf Pro on courts 4, 5 and 6. All net posts and furniture were replaced. The significant flooding was found to be due to carpet sickness.

We had hoped that courts 1, 2 and 3 would last another two years but after excessive rain this winter accumulated mud now dangerously comes to the surface and from an original carpet depth of 15mm we only have 5mm left. Chilterns, our previous contractors, have inspected the courts and their quote has been accepted by the tennis and management committees to carry out the same work as undertaken on courts 4, 5 and 6.

The work started on Monday 17 February, replacing the existing carpet with Tiger turf pro and replacing all net posts and net furniture.

Having inspected the underneath surface, it was agreed to include a new sub base by adding an extra top layer of asphalt and replace the perimeter edge at a cost of £27,262.00 excluding VAT. The original base on courts 1 and 2 was laid over 40 years ago and was starting to break up. A new carpet laid on a poor sub base was not an option. Work is due to be completed by Friday 13 March subject to the weather! Once the work is completed, we will have six new courts, that, if looked after well, should last for the fifteen years.

We have been advised that the courts require weekly brushing regardless of the weather and an annual deep clean after their second year. This work will now be undertaken. Tiger Turf Pro courts are expected to last 15 years. The replacement cost for all six courts is approximately £120,000.00. To ensure they last the full 15 years it is important to ensure your tennis shoes are clean. Please use the path and refrain from cutting across the grass, however tempting!

We will spend some money on the grass courts this year to improve the playing surface. It is still hoped, if financially viable, that the courts will be replaced with an all-weather surface.
