

RYDE LAWN TENNIS CLUB COVID-19 POLICY FROM THURSDAY 31 DECEMBER 2020

Social distancing must be maintained before, during and after play

Court limits for tennis and croquet

Maximum of two people per court (**singles play only**). Players can be from different households

The only exception to the above is where a group of four players are all from the same household, in which case they can play doubles

Adult coached sessions will be limited to 1:1 coaching only

Juniors will be coached in groups of no more than 12

Before you Play

**On arrival, please check in by scanning the QR code using your COVID-19 NHS App
The code has been displayed on the notice board and the club house window**

You must stay at home if you:

Have been in contact with someone with COVID-19 in the last **10** days

Have flu-like symptoms

If you are in a high-risk health category please think carefully before booking a session

Wash or sanitise your hands before and after play

Booking for tennis or croquet

All courts must be pre booked on line via "RLTCC clubspark booking"

Only paid-up members for 2020/21 can book/use the facilities at this time.

Members are not permitted to bring guests to the club at this time

One parent/guardian should accompany children under the age of 16, unless they are playing doubles within their household

Equipment

Avoid using your hands to pick up tennis balls that aren't yours – use your racket/foot to return them to your opponent or to another court

Please avoid going onto an adjacent court. If your ball ends up on another court wait for it to be returned

Travelling to and from the club

Avoid using public transport

Players should travel to the club alone, or only with a member of the same household

Arrive no earlier than 5 minutes before your booked time

Ensure you leave the court 15 minutes before the end of your session and leave the club grounds promptly and before the next group is due to arrive

Do not congregate after play – please leave the club grounds promptly

If you become unwell after playing, you should follow the Government's "track and trace" guidelines, which can be read on the Gov.uk website and then inform the club
