GUIDANCE FOR PLAYERS AT RYDE LAWN TENNIS AND CROQUET CLUB**General advice**

Hand washing and/or sanitising is still essential

Sanitiser is available but you are still advised to bring your own

**Outside taps situated on the side of the clock house and outside the kitchen window,
are available for handwashing**

Keep your distance of two metres from other players whenever possible

The clubhouse will remain closed. Players should therefore arrive ready to play

**Please take particular care if using the outside disabled toilet. Cleaning equipment and
instructions are available**

Booking courts

**All tennis and croquet courts must be pre booked on line via "RLTCC clubspark
booking". Please contact ms.rltcc@btinternet.com should you require any assistance.**

Please pay your subscriptions for 2021/22 to ensure booking facility remains available.

**The clubspark booking system will allow you to book 7 sessions throughout a 7-day
rolling period. Please be considerate to other members if requiring numerous bookings
and perhaps leave booking some of your sessions to just the day before.**

Members must accompany guests.

**Agreed charge of £6.00 (adults) and £3.00 (juniors) per visit for maximum of 4 visits or a
weekly membership of £25.00 (adults) £15.00 (juniors). Members are responsible for
booking and collecting fees and passing money to Sarah Sheppard (membership sec.)**

**One parent/guardian should accompany children under the age of 12, unless they are
playing doubles within their household. They are not counted as part of the maximum
group size, but should be off court, with social distancing strictly observed while
watching the sessions.**

It is recommended that children over the age of 12 are supervised by a parent/guardian or nominated adult

Travelling to and from the club

Arrive no earlier than 5 minutes before your booked time

Ensure you leave the court 15 minutes before the end of your session and leave the club grounds promptly and before the next group is due to arrive

Do not congregate after play – please leave the club grounds promptly

Specific rules for Croquet

Croquet balls and spare mallets will be in the croquet shed. Please return equipment after your game

Hoops will be left in place

Do not use clips or ball markers. Use personal markers to keep the score if required

Players should be their own referees and acknowledge faults and errors if they occur

Coaching

Coached sessions will be limited to no more than five adults per court people (four players plus the coach) on one court as long as the two-metre ruling can be observed

Group Junior coaching must not exceed 12 children in a compound

We recommend that payment to coaches be made via online banking

Adhering to the rules

Members should remind other members of the guidelines, in a positive way, if they witness inappropriate practice.
